



BOARD OF DIRECTORS CALL FOR NOMINEES FOR 2019

Deadline for accepting nominations is Sept. 3, 2018

The Nominating Committee of the Chesapeake Region Chapter, Community Associations Institute, is now accepting petitions from any Chapter member interested in running for the open positions on the Chapter Board of Directors.

Ballots will be mailed by October 1, 2018 and the results will be announced at the Annual Meeting & Social on November 16, 2018. The new Board member's term will begin January 1, 2019 and end December 31, 2021. Board members may serve no more than two consecutive three-year terms as a Director. Those years of service do not have to be consecutive. After the first three year term has ended, Directors must reapply and submit an application for re-election. After a member has served for six years, they may not serve again for three years. All Board Nomination Candidates must be members of the Chesapeake Chapter in good standing, have been a member of the Chapter for two (2) years and have served the Chapter within the past three (3) years in one of the following capacities: Committee Member, Seminar Instructor, Event Presenter or Sponsor. Manager/Community Association Leader and Homeowner (CAVL) Candidates must be an individual member (attending events under your community or employer's memberships does not count). CAICRC Board members generally meet once a month, usually in the Linthicum or Glen Burnie areas.

OPEN POSITIONS: (See the Bylaws in your CRC Directory or on the website www.caimdches.org for a description of each board position.) **There are five (5) open Director positions to serve from 2019-2021. At least one position must be filled by a Homeowner.**

Per Article VI; Section 2 Composition of the Board: "No more than one person from any company/association may serve on the Board at any one time." "The composition of At-Large seats on the Board of Directors shall not provide any one membership category CAVL (Homeowner), MGR, BP (Business Partner) with more than fifty percent (50%) of the seats or four (4) seats out of nine (9) on the Board of Directors."

In order to preserve the balance of the Board, there is a requirement that there be no more than two Directors from any one area of specialization. There are four (4) current Board Members still serving their 1st or 2nd term and therefore not up for re-election include the following areas of specialization: one manager (**Condominium Venture, Inc.**) and three business partners (one attorney from **Cowie & Mott, P.A.**, one engineering/consultant specialist from **Becht Engineering** and one consultant from **DoodyCalls Pet Waste Removal**).

Per Article VI; Section 4 Nomination & Election of Directors: **No candidate may campaign or cause another individual or individuals to campaign on behalf of the candidate. A candidate campaigning for election who is elected shall be disqualified from serving.**

If you have the leadership abilities and the desire to serve the community association industry, service on the Chesapeake Region Chapter's Board of Directors will be a rewarding experience. **If you are interested in serving on the Board, please complete and return the required form on or before September 3, 2018. If further space is needed, please attach an additional sheet to this application.**

Please know this information will go on the Chapter Ballot.
